## **Changes to the 2011 League**

- ***You must be a member of the CDGC to play Tuesday League***
- ***Visiting out of towners can play without a CDGC membership***
- ***Weekly fee increased to \$10/week***
- ***Weekly payout increased from \$4 to \$5***
- ***\$1/week goes to the CDGC fund for future disc golf development and operating costs.***

6:15 PM Check-in/Player's meeting/previous weeks \$ distributed

(Meet at the picnic table near the #1 tee-off)

6:30 PM Tee-off

All done by ~8:30 PM.

(Random doubles till dark)

## **Format:**

18 holes, in groups of 4 or 5. Groups and starting tee-off holes will be picked at random. Shotgun Start. Finish the front 9 completely before going to the back nine.

**Cost: \$10/week** (all amounts due before start of the game)

The \$10/week consists of:

### **\$5 - Payout for the night**

**\$2 - Finals/special awards pot.** This is basically the playoff cash and special awards at the end of the season, \$1 to each.

**\$1 - Progressive ace pot.** This ace pot will max out at \$100, and a new one will be started. If any ace pot money is left over at the end of the 15 weeks, half will go to the playoff prize and half will be rolled over to the following year. This year we are carrying over \$24, so we have a \$24 pot plus the amount for the first night. Should start out at about \$50.

**\$1 - Additional Ace Pot** on the old Hole #1 tee-off. \$1/week for a chance to get the Ace on hole # 1, like a mini Ace Race with cash! To be played after you complete hole #9 and when there is no interference with the players on hole #1. There will be a marked line on the ground at the old #1 tee-off. We will let this pot get as big as it gets in regular season. It is starting out this year at \$188 carry over from last year, plus the amount for the first night. Should start out well over \$200!

**\$1 - CDGC** to go towards for future course development in Calgary

***This would make the 2011 “full meal deal” \$10/week.***  
*(never has making change been so easy.....)*

### **Scoring**

Score cards are marked by another person in your group, chosen randomly by your group. You can not score your own card. At the end of the round, count the score on the card you are marking, total it and mark it down. You can then sign the card off and return it the player. You also need to count your own scorecard and verify the total that the marker has given it by signing your card as well. It is your responsibility to hand in your scorecard at the end of the round.

### **Average Scores**

This year we will continue to use average scores from past league nights. This helps to even the field - any skill level can win any given week! Just shoot better than you usually do, and you have a shot at winning.

In an effort to make the competition tighter, and more fair, there will now be 2 league pools divided by an average score cutoff. Your average is based on your last **5** scores.

This average on week one will determine your Pool placement. For week 1 pool list, see last page.

Pool A            <= 57.00 (31 existing players)  
Pool B            > 57.00 (28 existing players)

These Pool groupings will be refreshed after weeks 5, 10 and 15 using the cut-off of whatever gives the most even split between the pools. The week 15 reshuffle will determine playoff Pools.

Also new will be for averages that are +10 or more over par, these averages must be re-established if they have not posted a score in the past year

### **CDGC Score Averaging System The Basics**

New players have to play for 3 weeks to establish their average, but will be allowed to compete for cash using a score of 100 in Pool B only. For players that have scores from last years league, your average is the calculated from your last 5 league results, including playoff scores. To see the list of handicaps and Pool placements calculated from last years league scores, see the last page of this document.

Winners on each night are determined by taking the score and dividing by the average, then multiplying by 100. For example, if your average is 58.31 and your score that night is 55;  $58.31 / 55 = 1.06018 * 100 = 106.02$ . (We are multiplying it by 100 for ease of reading.) Anything over 100 is under your average; anything under 100 is over your average. The bigger the number, the better.

The above example in Pool A shows 3 players each gets 2 strokes better than their average score. You can see that this will even things out somewhat because it takes into account that it is harder for a player with a better average to gain 2 strokes on their average, than it is for a player with a worse average. (or so they will tell you....) :o)

The number of winners for the night and the payouts amounts depend on the number of players in each Pool. Payouts are based on the attached table and are separate for each Pool. Every week all the averages are recalculated and will be shown on the scorecards the next week. A full list will be available weekly on the website. Your average is based on the last 5 scores that you have submitted so that everyone has the same chance to move their average. Players with less than 5 scores will have their averages based on their currently available number of scores. A minimum of 3 scores is required to establish an average. Your average will be updated on your scorecard each week. Each scorecard has been designed to hold 5 weeks of scores and averages.

### **Basic Points System**

Points are calculated to determine the top 16 players for the end of year playoffs. If you are a new player, you will earn 100 points per night until you have recorded three scores. You are still required to pay the \$6 weekly fee. If you are a player that has an existing average score, then points will be awarded as follows.

- Nightly score is just your ratio of Average/ Score multiplied by 100
- The **BEST** 10 scores will be added together to determine the final 16 players.
- You will need a minimum 10 scores qualify for the finals

### **End of Regular Season Awards**

We have 4 extra awards to recognize a few areas:

- **Best increase in average over the season** – Difference in average from last week played to first. A minimum of 10 weeks must be played to be eligible for this award. Players without an average on first night of play are not eligible.
- **Most weeks attended** – The person(s) with the highest number of weeks attendance will be awarded the prize. If more than 1 winner, the prize will be split equally.
- **Lowest under par score** – The person who gets the lowest under par score over all the weeks.
- **Most weeks beating your own average** – The person(s) who can better their average the most times during the season.

The awards payout will consist of the extra \$1 collected each week divided evenly between the 4 awards. These awards will be given at the end of the regular season.

## Finals

At the end of 15 weeks the players **BEST** 10 scores will be averaged to determine the top 8 players in each Pool. These players will playoff in the next four weeks in an elimination style ladder to determine the overall winner. (kind of like the NHL playoffs) The final pot will consist of the extra \$1 collected each week.

Any remaining Ace Pot \$ from the Ace Pots will be divided in half and one half will be rolled over to the next year, and the other half will be added to the finals money.

Your average will not be adjusted after the regular season. You play all the playoff games with your final average from the season.

NOTE: You must have a minimum of 10 scores to qualify for the finals. There are **no** weekly fees and both of the ace pots will **not** be in effect during playoffs. The total Championship Final amount will be divided between the top three players. 4<sup>th</sup> place gets a big goose egg.

**1st Place 70%    2nd Place 20%    3<sup>rd</sup> Place 10%**

## Course Rules

### Out of Bounds

There is a one stroke penalty if your disc comes to rest as follows:

All Holes – Completely surrounded by any sidewalk or asphalt pavement  
- Beyond the sidewalk

NOTE: There will be NO 2 metre Out-of Bounds rule. If you disc comes to rest in a tree, take your next shot directly under where the disc was in the tree. You do NOT take a stroke.

## SAFETY

REMEMBER - Park users always have the right of way! Do NOT throw if there is any chance of an errant disc hitting someone. Wait until it is clear, or send out a spotter. Please pick up any trash you may come across and deposit into the garbage bins.
