**Registration:**

Please pre-register at the Alberta Disc Golf Page [www.albertadiscgolf.com](http://www.albertadiscgolf.com). Payment of your entry fee can be made either at early registration Friday evening or final registration Saturday morning. Exact change greatly appreciated. You will be issued a plastic wristband that you will need to wear throughout the weekend.

**Guest passes**

Disc Golf players registered in the tournament may purchase up to 3 (three) guest passes for the Parkland Solstice Festival 2007 weekend for their spouses,

partners, friends, etc. Guest tickets can be purchased on Friday night for \$25. These guest tickets will be \$30 each on Saturday. Guest tickets must be purchased at the time of Disc Golf registration. These guest tickets can then be exchanged for wristbands on Saturday from the Park 96 check-in at the gates. Children aged 17 and under are admitted free of charge and must enter with an adult with paid admission to be issued a wristband. For guests interested in only attending the event on Sunday, the cost is \$10 and those tickets can be bought at the gate from Park 96 staff on Sunday.

### **The Venue:**

Park 96 in the community of Parkland is a private park owned and operated by the local homeowner's association. The park has many amenities including two outdoor skating rinks, 5 tennis courts, basketball half courts and a championship style 18 basket disc golf course. Preview the disc golf course on the Alberta Disc Golf page where you will find pictures and measurements of all fairways. New playground equipment and a water park feature have recently been installed making this an ideal place for kids and adults to play in a safe family environment.

### **Directions:**

Park96 is extremely easy to find. Travel south of 16th Ave (Trans Canada) on Deerfoot Trail. Once you pass Southland Drive stay in the middle lane and take the exit to Bow Bottom Trail. Continue on Bow Bottom Trail south past Canyon Meadows Drive until you reach 146th Ave, turn right on 146th Ave and proceed west to Parkland Blvd, then right on Parkland Blvd to the park entrance. (The park and several disc golf baskets will be visible on your right side as you travel the last few hundred yards on Bow Bottom Trail and 146th Ave.)

### **The Solstice Festival:**

The Alberta Open is being held concurrently with the Parkland Solstice Festival 2007. Go to [www.park96.com](http://www.park96.com) to view a list of the musical guests in the park Saturday and Sunday. Parkland Community has arranged all the entertainment, beer gardens, barbeques, art exhibitions, etc. and is providing all the necessary infrastructure eg: liability insurance, porta-sans, etc. There is a \$25 'user fee' included in all Summer Solstice Disc Golf entry fees which allows the entrant complete access to all the activities and music both Saturday and Sunday.

### **Practice Round:**

Park 96 is hosting a private function for BP Canada Energy Company Friday evening, June 23, but players may register at Park 96 at 7:00PM and play one 18 basket practice round on the course.

### **Disc Golf Mentorship with BP:**

Opportunities to mentor a BP guest may occur on Friday night. If you chose to mentor you will receive a custom disc and you will be invited to have dinner and a non-alcoholic drink courtesy of BP.
