Final Registration: Saturday morning October 17 from 8 AM to 9 AM at Disc Central.

Disc Central: All players meetings, registration and scoring will occur at Disc Central, located throughout the weekend at the 'Picnic Shelter' in Nicholas Sheran Park, located approximately 100 yards Southwest of the McMaster Boulevard Parking Lot.

The Rules: The 15th Alberta Open is a sanctioned PDGA 'C' Tier event.
Team play on Monday will be stroke play; no alternate formats for this event.
Pro Open will play black tees, Pro Masters will play blue tees and all Pro Women, Grandmasters and Amateurs will play white tees, unless other wise directed by the Tournament Director.

The Venue: Nicholas Sheran Park is located 2 blocks west of the Main Entrance to the University of Lethbridge. Four streets border the park: Laval Blvd. to the east, Columbia Blvd. to the north, McMaster Blvd. to the west and McGill Blvd. to the south. Covering 117 acres of gently rolling, partially wooded, manicured park landscape, the park is a few dozen yards away from a busy shopping plaza. Backstreet Bar and Eatery, exactly ½ block north of the # 15 tee box on Laval Blvd., is highly recommended.

The Course: Installed in 2001 for the Alberta Seniors Games, the disc golf course at Nicholas Sheran Park was largely re-designed for the 2007 Alberta Open. Believed to be the second longest 18 basket layout in the world, players will find one basket installed on each of the two island fairways (#12 and # 13), so water does come into play.

In addition to the water around the island baskets, Lethbridge can be very windy!
The tournament layout measures 3136 meters off the black tees, 2867 meters off the blues and 2271 off the whites.

Par for the Nicholas Sheran disc golf course during the 15th Alberta Open will set at 64. (3 x Par 5s (1, 10 and 16) 4 x Par 4s (7, 9, 14 and 18) and 11 Par 3s.)

All 18 baskets are uniform 'Turbofunnels' similar to the baskets found at the Canmore, Olds, Cardston, or Three Hills.

These 'Turbofunnel' baskets meet all PDGA standards, but the chain on the Lethbridge versions is slightly heavy and seems to favor heavy, soft putters.
